

Dario Designs on the Job from Brazil to Boston

NEW YORK Architects and operations consultants Dario Designs, Marlboro, Mass., has been retained for projects at some of the largest newspapers in Brazil, the Bahamas and New England.

The firm will provide a masterplan and strategic planning services for O Globo, Rio de Janeiro's largest daily, production consulting for The Tribune, the biggest Bahamian newspaper based in Nassau, and consulting and masterplanning for The Boston Globe.

Dario Designs also reports that it has been retained by its former landlord, Boston-based Wellesley Companies, for interior designs and masterplan services for its 1.2-million-square-foot facility in Maynard, Mass. Dario Designs describes the site as the state's largest office conversion of a historic mill complex, where the original building dates from 1847.

- Wellesley Co. in Maynard Mass., for interior designs and masterplan services for a 1.2 million square-foot former mill that is being converted to offices.
