

GATES breaks ground on Naples Daily News

GATES Builders was selected to build the new office, printing and distribution facility for the Naples Daily News. GATES competed with several other local firms in the competitive bid process over the course of one year, providing preconstruction services. GATES broke ground on the 186,583-square-foot printing and headquarters facility for the Naples Daily News this month. The facility will feature a state-of-the-art printing press.



Construction will also include all 18 acre site work and utilities. Located on an 18 acre site on Immokalee Road in North Naples, this \$30-\$40 million dollar project is expected to be completed in the summer of 2009. The project was designed by Dario Designs Inc.



Naples Daily News begins plant construction

The Naples (Fla.) Daily News last week broke ground on its new \$95-million production plant and administrative offices.

The 183,000-square-foot building will be anchored by a WIFAG evolution 371 press. The Daily News said the project will continue regardless of whether the paper can sell its current downtown headquarters, currently listed for sale.

The new building is expected to be completed next year, Dario Designs Inc. is overseeing design of the plant, which is being constructed by a local contractor.
