## Janesville Gazette kicks off new \$22 million facility

The Janesville (Wis.) Gazette Oct. 22 began producing papers on new press and postpress equipment. The Gazette went on-eiditon with a Koenig Bauer AG Comet press anchoring its \$22 million plant designed by Dario Designs Inc.

In addition to the press, The Gazette moved posproduction to a 16:2 SLS3000 inserter from Muller Martini Mailroom Systems. The system is equipped with StacLines for stacker communication control, BundLine for monitoring and control of bundle formation, KeyLine for the creation of key bundles and DualLine, which enables the inserter to create two distinct zones simultaneously during newspaper inserting.
