New Wisconsin plant on track

A new 54,000-square-foot plant being built for Bliss Communications in Janesville, WI, will be in full production during the fourth quarter of the year, according to dario Designs Inc., which managed portions of the facility's construction.

Bliss, which prints The Janesville Gazette and other area publications, is building the plant around a Comet press from Koenig & Bauer AG. It also tapped Kodak, and Quipp Systems Inc., and Muller Martini Mailroom Systems for computer-to-plate and postpress equipment, respectively.

Dario Designs said it oversaw four parts of the plant's construction, including masterplanning, production operations consulting, equipment RFP, and architecture and engineering.
