NY Times plant picks up 3 local awards

NEW YORK The New York Times production plant has received three new awards, including Best Industrial Interiors, Best New Construction -- Landscaping, and Best New Construction -- Industrial, from the Queens (NY) Chamber of Commerce.

Dario Designs was involved in Times' College Point plant project from its conception to completion. It is one of 16 "Consolidation -- Partnering -- Outsourcing" projects under way at Dario Designs.

Headquartered in Marlboro, Mass., Dario Designs has created software and metrics for evaluating and quantifying the operational statistics needed to make informed consolidation decisions.

Multimillion-dollar monthly savings have helped promote the consolidation trend. "Consolidation of printing, packaging, and distribution, as well as cooperation in news and advertising, are on the table for hundreds of newspapers throughout North America," Dario Design Vice President David Ehrhardt said in a statement.
