As Founder and President, Mr. DiMare is responsible for the supervision, coordination, and implementation of programming, design, and architectural activities. In addition, Mr. DiMare's involvement continues from Strategic Planning and efficiency consulting through procurement and construction. His creativity and passion for efficiency has been credited with saving companies millions of dollars annually in operating expenses.

Mr. DiMare's experience includes over 300 media projects varying in size from less than 10,000 circulation to more than 8,000,000. He has worked for all of the largest media companies in the USA including some of the largest in China, India, South America, Central America, and The Caribbean. Mr. DiMare has been published more than 50 times and has had numerous articles written about his company and his work. He is the recipient of ING's "Ozzie Newspaper Award". Dario Designs was and still is ranked by Belden Research as the world's best newspaper and media designers/consultants.

After rebounding from the downturn in media projects, Mr. DiMare has been involved with the design of several high rises in Boston; hotels in Florida; private schools; several 1,000 acre plus multi-use developments; senior living campuses and facilities; and many apartment complexes.

Prior to forming Dario Designs, Mr. DiMare won a competition to design the Eastern District Headquarters for his employer, The Austin Company, a design-build firm with more than 2,000 employees. More recently, he was responsible for masterplanning a \$4 billion, 30,000,000sf resort in South Viet Nam. He has a 100% track record for permitting projects across the country from San Francisco; Chicago; Miami; and New York City to Bellingham, WA; Bend, OR; Bangor, ME; and Anniston AL.
